#### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

By entering and allowing your vehicle to remain in this campground you agree to the terms and conditions listed below, and included in relevant campground policies. If you do not accept these terms and conditions, you must immediately remove your vehicle from the campground.

Camping fees are payable on entry

Maximum stay: 7 nights within a 21 day period

Sites are provided on first come, first served basis Camping sites may not be reserved in any way

Campers are asked to ensure the site is left clean and tidy for future users

All signage must be obeyed

Permits must be clearly visible on vehicle dashboard or van window so that expiry is legible

Sites cannot be reserved, including by way of personal items (i.e. tents, chairs, signage etc.) being left in the area for the intended purpose of camping there at a later time.

All persons camping in the area must, in addition to complying with the above conditions, comply with all applicable laws and Council by-laws including (but not limited to) in relation to the lighting of fires and interference with vegetation. Penalties for non-compliance apply.

Fires are permitted year-round, except on days declared a total fire ban day. Fires must always be contained to the designated fire drums provided.

Pets must be kept on a lead. If pets are causing a disturbance for other campers, you may be required to leave the campground.

The peaceful enjoyment of the campground and its facilities by all campers is important to Council.

Campers are asked to be considerate of neighbours and local residents, and restrict noise from radios, television and social gatherings after 9.00pm and before 8.00am.

No operational generators are permitted between the hours of 7:00pm and 8:00am.

If you fail to comply with these terms and conditions, penalties may apply.

DCLW may, at its discretion, revoke your permit to use its camping area and/or prohibit you from using any of its camping area by notice affixed to your vehicle or posted to the registered owner and you give your express consent to any such notice being affixed by DCLW to your vehicle.

DCLW will not under any circumstances be liable or responsible for any damage or loss; and all injury, loss or damage to person or property is at the risk of persons entering and/or leaving their vehicles in this area.

You agree to indemnify DCLW against any loss or damage it may suffer arising out of your negligence or breach of these terms and conditions.

No person other than the DCLW has authority to vary, waive or excuse compliance with any of these terms and conditions.
