1. Purpose

To specify the flags to be flown by the District Council of Loxton Waikerie.

2. Scope

This policy applies to the Loxton and Waikerie offices of the District Council of Loxton Waikerie.

Flying of flags at Council offices

- Strangman Road, Waikerie

are provided with 2 flagpoles and will fly either the Australian, South Australian, Australian Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander flags (the latter two as part of recognition arrangements that flow from the Indigenous Land Use Agreement that council is party to).
